Poštovani,

Podsećamo vas da je na 37. Kongresu Svetske odbojkaške federacije (FIVB), održanom 06. februara 2021. godine doneta odluka da se usvoji nekoliko predloženih izmena pravila odbojke i odbojke na pesku.

U svim takmičenjima u organizaciji FIVB primena tih usvojenih izmena pravila igre počće od 01. januara 2022. godine.

Evropska odbojkaška konfederacija (CEV) donela je odluku da primena usvojenih izmena pravila igre počne od starta Evropskih odbojkaških kupova u sezoni 2021-2022, odnosno od 21. septembra 2021. godine.

Imajući u vidu da i naši klubovi učestvuju u Evropskim kup takmičenjima u sezoni 2021-2022, kao i da mlađe selekcije OSS takođe u toku jeseni očekuju zonalne kvalifikacije za Evropska prvenstva 2022. godine, da bi se izbegla konfuzija ukoliko bi primena usvojenih izmena pravila igre počela u sred takmičarske sezone, Odbojkaški savez Srbije donosi

da primena usvojenih izmena pravila igre počne od početka takmičarske sezone 2021./2022., odnosno počev od 28. septembra 2021. godine u svim kategorijama i svim takmičenjima Odbojkaškog saveza Srbije.

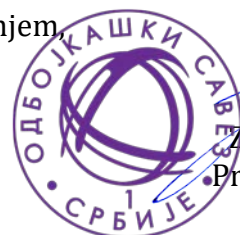
U prilogu ove Odluke nalaze se originalna verzija i prevod usvojenih izmena pravila igre i čine njen sastavni deo.
